Points To Remember When Making Virtual Videos

1. Keep It Relatable
 - What connections can you make between your life (garden, pets, etc) and your population of students?
2. Make it light hearted
 - Mistakes will be made and dogs will dig.
3. Focus on 1 topic/objective a video
 - Ask the kids thoughtful questions related to the topic.

Points To Remember When Making Virtual Videos

4. Connect video topic to literature and or other subjects

- If possible read a book connected to the topic and emphasize vocabulary.

5. Use Vocabulary Cards

- The visual reminder helps students process and remember the word and meaning if they hear, see, and if possible model the word.
